### Research and essay prizes for undergraduates

The following prizes are available to UK undergraduate clinical medical students:

#### Clinical oncology prizes

- **Research prize:** A prize of £400 for personal research on a clinical oncology topic.
- **Essay prize:** A prize of £200 for an essay either on a topic relevant to clinical oncology or describing personal experience of working in a department of clinical oncology during an elective period or vacation.

#### Clinical radiology prizes

- **Research prize:** A prize of £400 for personal research on a clinical radiology topic.
- **Essay prize:** A prize of £200 for an essay either on a topic relevant to clinical radiology or describing personal experience of working in a department of clinical radiology during an elective period or vacation.
